## Waitrose in Storrington

Waitrose is proposing to mount a public exhibition during the Summer, of their plans for a new store in the centre of Storrington. Kiafield Developments, acting on behalf of the John Lewis Partnership, owners of Waitrose, has purchased the garage and the adjacent buildings in Old Mill Drive with the aim of opening a store on the site in early 2011. The purchase also includes the right to build over the existing bus stop and roundabout in Old Mill Drive. Kiafield is in discussions with Horsham District Council (HDC) on plans to increase capacity of the existing car park by digging down. HDC recently issued a planning brief which looked at modernization and redevelopment of the whole of the Storrington diamond area (the area bounded by Old Mill Drive/Mill Lane, School Hill and the Colonnade shops in the High St). The brief, issued as a guide for any potential developer, apart from acknowledging the Waitrose plans, seeks to facilitate an update of the existing 1960's shopping precinct and also the shops and private car park at the top (north) of the diamond bordering on Mill Lane. It also envisages a second car park entrance/exit via Old Mill Drive, greatly improving pedestrian access from the Precinct to the rest of the High Street by the part or complete pedestrianization of the bottom end of Old Mill Drive and creating a "village centre" public area there with new public toilets and possibly a café. At present, however, Kiafield is the only developer to have entered into discussions with HDC and its current plans only include development of the Waitrose store and car park.

## Councils make budget cuts

Horsham District Council is currently undergoing a staff review and is looking to make cuts in its expenditure of some £2 million. It has begun by freezing items of capital expenditure and by a restructuring exercise which will initially see the loss of 5 jobs at a senior level of the organization. Further staff restructuring is expected to follow. The District Council is increasing Council Tax by 3%. More locally, Storrington and Sullington Parish Council has held its share of the Council Tax at levels below or at the level of inflation for the past four years and this year, after making budget cuts, the overall Parish Council Precept (tax) will increase by 1.49%. The final amount per household will depend on your house tax banding and the calculation per property has been made all the more difficult this year in that the total number of Council Tax dwellings sharing the cost has actually reduced for the first time in many years. The Government regards a band "D" house as being typical and in Storrington the overall figure for band "D" with Horsham District and Parish taxes combined will be £183.40. The District Council also collects Council Tax on behalf of the Police and the County Council and the average band "D" figures for these two organizations in 2009/10 will be £134.73 and £1,133.64 respectively.

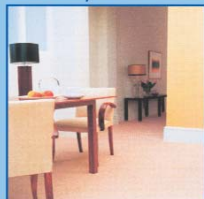
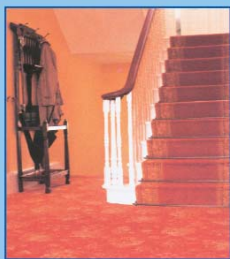
## Storrington & Sullington Community Partnership Annual Meeting

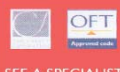

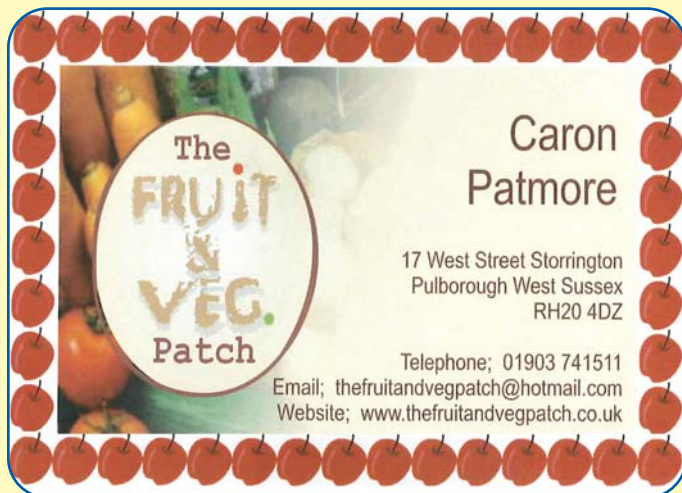

Logging onto the West Sussex County Council website [www.westsussex.gov.uk](http://www.westsussex.gov.uk) has never been easier to access for the visually impaired and people with literacy or learning difficulties. A piece of software called Browsealoud has recently been added to the County Council's website - and by moving your mouse over the text on a web page allows you to hear the words being spoken aloud. Browsealoud is completely free and works with popular web browsers such as Internet Explorer and Firefox. It even lets you choose whether you would like to listen to a male or female voice - and it can read both Word and PDF documents. By clicking on a word you do not understand, you can call up a dedicated online talking dictionary to check its meaning. You can also save text as an MP3 file, allowing you to listen to it whenever you like. Do you know some one who could benefit from this service? ## Ex-landlord haunts the White Horse

This fascinating building dates back to 1535 and has great atmosphere and welcoming staff - it also has a resident ghost! The ghost is like so many others that haunt pubs; playful and mischievous but generally friendly. The spirit that haunts the White Horse is thought to be an ex-landlord but it is not certain which one. The spirit likes to touch guests and staff members and the temperature can suddenly drop to being icy cold before returning to normal. Footsteps and shuffling noises have been reported by guests both in the corridor and in the rooms, and one ex-landlady was even lifted off her feet. The most famous ghost story connected to the White Horse concerns Sir Arnold Bax who lived at the inn from 1940 until he died in 1952. Twenty-five years after his death, a letter arrived at the pub addressed to his executors. As it was Christmas time the letter was put temporarily in his old room until the festive period was over. When it was collected to be returned to the Post Office a large, dirty mark was spotted on the envelope and some say it looked as though it had been trodden on whilst others claimed that it had been dragged through mud. This was odd considering that during the time the letter was in a room where the door had remained locked.

## Storrington & District Museum

Walk up Church Street, containing some of Storrington's best preserved old houses, turn right at the Parish Church and on your left you will see the Old School, housing Storrington's own museum of local and family history. If you want to find out about our heritage, or your own family roots, this is the place to begin your search. Established since 2000, records and artefacts of local interest continue to grow. There is a large archive of photographs of Storrington and surrounding villages, census records and transcripts of the parish registers.

As well as regular special exhibitions showcasing particular topics, the museum hosts annual open events which, in the past, have included Home Guard and WWII days, a Victorian Harvest Home, an Edwardian Flower Show and a Roman Day. Other activities include an annual Family History Day with expert organisations on hand to help with enquiries, summer walks and monthly lectures during winter.

## Agencies Pool Resources with Positive Results for Young People and Broader Community

A joint initiative involving Horsham District Council, West Sussex County Council, Storrington and Sullington Parish Council, The Chanctonbury Leisure Centre, Sussex Police, Action in Rural Sussex, Raglan Homes, Saxon Weald and The Storrington and Sullington Community Partnership is having a positive impact on the lives of young people in the Parish.

The initiative harnesses the skills and responsibilities of each of the partner organisations and provides activities, advice and support for teenagers whilst challenging and deterring inappropriate behaviour. Elements of the initiative include outreach youth workers engaging with young people at Storrington Recreation Ground on a Monday and Thursday night, youth clubs at Rydon School on a Tuesday and Thursday night, church youth workers in Mill Square on a Monday night, mini bus access to the girls club at Steyning Youth Wing on a Wednesday night, Thursday night football at the Leisure Centre on a Thursday and drop in facilities and cooking for young people to be re-introduced at Forge House. These activities augment the existing activities provided at the Leisure Centre or through voluntary youth organisations such as scouts, church youth clubs and the sports clubs and help to engage young people who are not involved in more formal provision. Many participants have responded positively and early results show an increase in positive participation and a decrease in local disturbances. It is now hoped that, with the involvement of local businesses, some young people will receive further support to gain employment and confidence through the introduction of a Youth Enterprise Scheme.

## New Village Parking Controls

Parking tariffs are now in operation throughout the village on all public car parks with the first two hours free (on display of a disc) and extra hours at 50p per hour (by displaying vouchers). ## Action against HGVs

County Councillor, Frank Wilkinson and District Councillors, Jim Sanson, Chris Mason, and Ray Dawe, met with West Sussex County Council highway officials to discuss growing concerns about the number of HGVs using Storrington as a shortcut to avoid other congested routes. WSCC have an "Advisory Lorry Route Map" which is used to direct haulage vehicles along the major 'A' roads in the county and not through country lanes or villages. Whilst some lorries are genuinely using Storrington to transport goods to our shops and local businesses, it is thought that other HGVs are using the route as a "Rat-Run" to avoid the problems on the A27 at Worthing and Arundel.

## Dealing with Junk Mail

During 2008, British households and businesses received 42 billion items of unwanted mail - the equivalent of 6.6 million trees! If you would like to reclaim your letterbox, follow the advice below:

- Register with the Direct Marketing Association (DMA) to remove your name and address from mailing lists. Write to them at Mailing Preference Services, Freepost 29, (LON22771) London W1 7EZ, or register online at [www.mpsonline.org.uk/mpsr](http://www.mpsonline.org.uk/mpsr)
- Look for "Opt out of direct marketing" tick boxes on forms that you fill in when ordering goods.
- Electoral Register - tick the "edited register" option when completing the annual form. This will keep your details out of the publicly available register.
- Register with your utility providers for on-line billing to end paper bills.
- Tell your credit card company, Bank and Mortgage provider that you do not want to receive marketing information and ask them not to pass on your details to other companies.
- Finally, if you don't want it, please recycle it!

## Storrington Widow tricked into being a money mule

An elderly widow from Storrington has fallen victim to a prize draw scam which has tricked people into handing over wads of cash. The scam involves the victims being told that they had won an international sweepstake or prize draw but in order to claim the winnings, they would have to pay refundable taxes and insurance fees. The fraudsters instructed their prey to send cheques to British "Agents" - typically other victims of fraud. These people who received the money had often exhausted their own savings in the same scam and were told that the funds were from sponsors who wished to help them receive their winnings. They were told to bank the cheques and send the money overseas to obtain their prize. The Storrington victim innocently laundered £21,000 after receiving seven separate cheques when her own funds had been depleted.

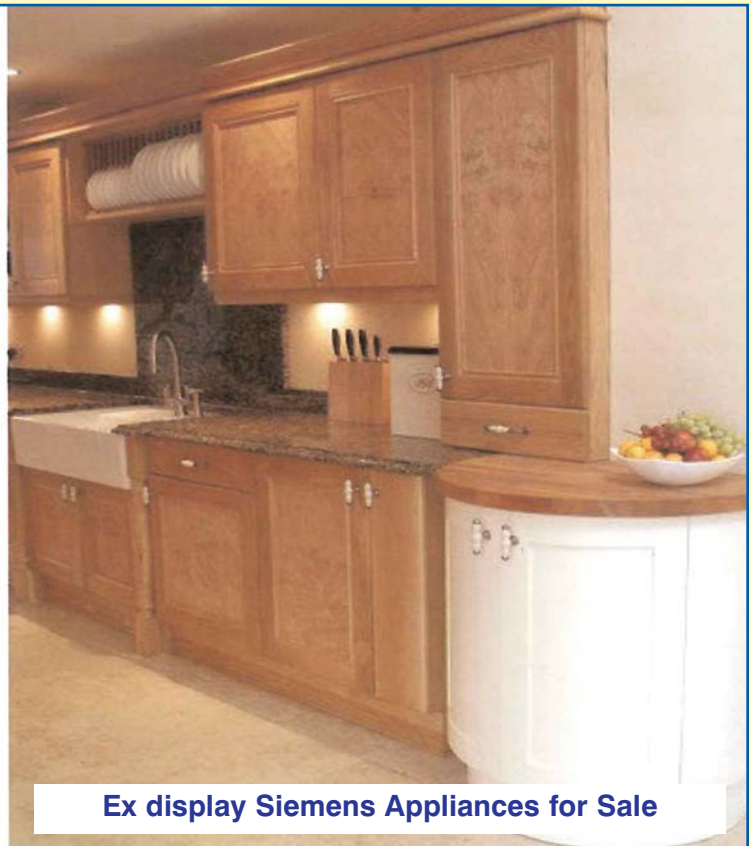
